

# Wine label collection

The collection comprises of about 1000 items, mostly English and French Enamel Wine Labels. An approximate itemization can be seen below.

**Early English Enamel Wine Labels.** Approximately 140 labels , of which 7 are Ravenet (battersea) labels,



and about 10 have some significant damage. Many of these can be seen in the Early Enamels paper in this article

**Early French Enamel Wine Labels.** Approximately 120 labels, a small number have significant damage. Many of these can be seen in the Early Enamels paper in this article.

Later French Enamel wine labels.

**Staffordshire English Enamel Wine Labels.** In total, one double sized label (the only one I have ever seen)



approximately 210 regular size and 75 small sized labels. 10+ have significant damage.

**Samson of Paris French Enamel Wine Labels.** Approximately 100 labels



## Later French Enamel Wine labels.

Kidney shaped labels, approximately 138 labels. Metal backed labels, approximately 28, often seen instead of copper in later bin labels, street numbers and small publicity plaques. Another 30 odd miscellaneous French labels.



French Bin labels. 20+ Some of these can be seen in my Zinc Bin Labels article



Miscellaneous English and French labels. 200+ These are labels that cannot easily be characterized into the groups above, because of shape, decoration, and the lack of similar labels. Some examples shown below.
